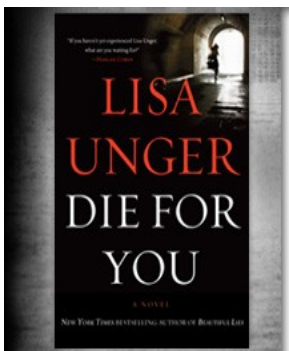
Loss of a Treasure and Friend

Christopher (Chris) L. Henderson passed away on May 5, 2009 at the age of 82.

Born in Jackson, Mississippi, he retired when he was 45 years old and spent the rest of his life in public service. Because of his love of the City of Safety Harbor and especially the Safety Harbor Library, his family has requested donations to the Safety Harbor Library Foundation in lieu of flowers or other gifts.

Chris loved to read, share and donate his time and experience. Chris served on the Long Range Planning Committee in 2003-2004, which started the process for the Library expansion and renovation. Chris was a member of the Library Foundation Board, the Friends of the Library, and the Safety Harbor Garden Club, serving at one point as its President. Chris is survived by his wife Carolyn, two daughters, Kate Kuhn and Rebecca Weikel, and one son, Christopher J. Henderson.

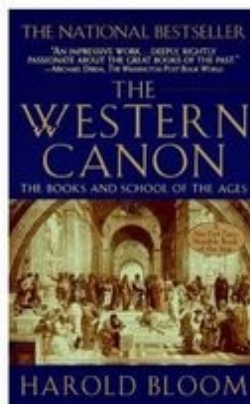

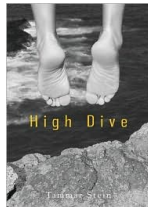
