Important Changes to Borrowing Privileges for Non-Pinellas County Hillsborough Residents

Reciprocal Borrowing Ends September 30, 2008

Due to the Hillsborough County Public Library's withdrawal from the Reciprocal Borrowing contract, the Pinellas Public Library Cooperative's Board approved ending participation in the reciprocal borrowing program with Hillsborough County.

\$100 Annual Fee for Non-resident Cards

As of **October 1, 2008**, library customers who live in Hillsborough County and wish to continue borrowing materials from Pinellas County's public libraries may pay an **annual fee of \$100 per household** to obtain a non-resident card.

You may obtain your non-resident library card at the circulation desk at any library location in the Pinellas Public Library Cooperative. Cash or check payments will be accepted and proof of identification and address will be required.
